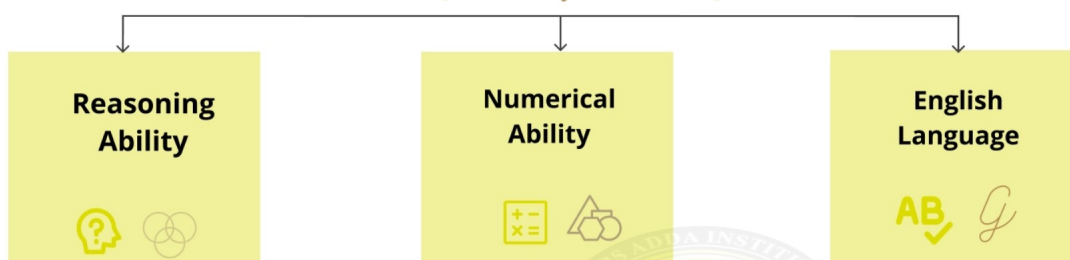

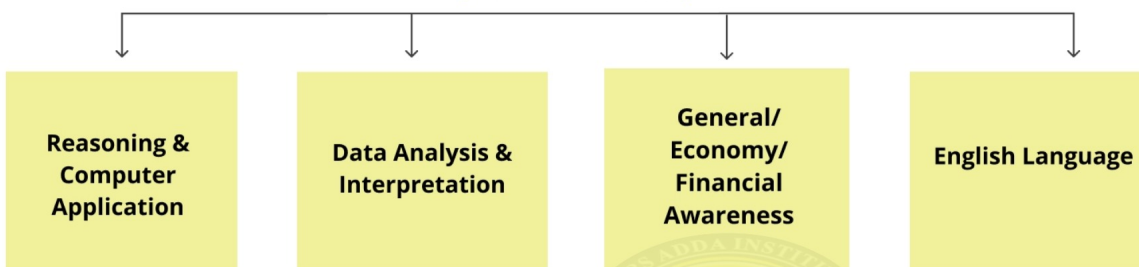

Similarly, each incorrect answer incurs a negative marking of 0.25 mark or 1/4 of the assigned mark.
